In 1992 the Israeli state chose Kavod (כבוד), not equality, as its key value. The Hebrew term, claims Orit Kamir (2004), encompass four related, complementing and contradicting concepts: dignity, honor, respect and glory. As individuals residing and working in an honor-based society, we often struggle with its premises and encounter various challenges to maintain and promote glory, dignity and respect. In this meeting we invite scholars studying gender and conflict/resolution to reflect on how aspects of dignity, honor, respect and glory meet and intersect in their research, activism, and lived experiences.

Kavod, Gender, and Conflict Resolution, is the second meeting of The Sophie Davis Learning Community. The meetings aim to create a scholarly community that will develop various creative and innovative collaborations around these themes. The first meeting focused on Hope (Dec). The following meetings will focus on the concepts: Translation (March), Compassion (April), Belonging (May).
